

## Take Home Activity: Ice Age Mammal Cut-out

### Directions

1. With adult supervision, carefully cut out each page of Ice Age Mammals.
2. Try piecing them together. If you are stuck, look at the hand-outs included or on The Mammoth Site website, <https://www.mammothsite.org/what-we-do/education/fun-learning-activities.html>.
  - a. Each animal should have at least four legs, a body(torso), and a head.
3. Color each animal after you piece them together.
  - a. Think about the time and environment these animals would have lived in. How would they keep warm?
  - b. If you'd like, you can use brass fasteners or a glue stick to keep your animal together.
4. Look at your mammoth and short-faced bear.
  - a. What features do they share?
  - b. What features does the mammoth have that the short-faced bear does not?
  - c. What features does the short-faced bear have that the mammoth does not?
  - d. Using the information provided, how do you think these animals might have interacted?
